RE: Case 00-M-0504 Unbundled Bill Format

Dear Ms. Sloane:

On November 9, 2006, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") submitted to you its unbundled bill formats for full-service (sales) customers. The bill formats were consistent with the unbundled gas rates that had been filed with the Company's gas rate case, 06-G-1332, and with the unbundled electric rates that were subsequently filed with the Company's electric rate case, 07-E-0523. Since then, based on the Joint Proposal entered into by the parties in Case 06-G-1332, the Company submitted to you on July 18, 2007, revised dual-service bill formats that took into account the rate unbundling reflected in that proposal, which was approved by the Commission on September 19, 2007, with new gas rates to be effective October 1, 2007. These formats will be utilized by the Company until new, unbundled electric rates are effective on April 1, 2008.

The Company is submitting further revised bill formats now to account for changes expected to be required by resolution of the Company's pending electric rate

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case. First, the Company expects that the Merchant Function Charge ("MFC") will be modified so that all retail access customers will be exempt from paying the charge. This will be possible because the Company has proposed to conform the methodology for calculating the Purchase of Receivables discount to the methodology adopted in the just-approved gas rate plan, with the Company's supply-related credit and collections costs being included in the discount computation. Second, the Billing and Payment Processing ("BPP") Charge will be shown as a part of the Basic Service Charge for full-service customers taking service under residential service classifications and for full-service customers with monthly maximum demand under 50 kW taking service under non-residential service classifications.¹ For these customers, the specific amount of the BPP Charge will be indicated in the definition and the customer informed that the charge is avoidable.² Use of the same method of display as adopted for the gas BPP Charge will reduce customers' concerns that a new charge is being imposed.

With these two changes, the Company will no longer have to have a "Miscellaneous" section on the bill, which the Company had proposed in its November 2006 submission, to capture charges that may or may not be avoided by retail access customers.

Because the Company proposed to continue the "bridge bill" format for electric billing through the first six months of unbundled gas billing, the Company expects that

¹ The cut-off at 50 kW reflects the different treatment of metering charges for customers eligible for competitive metering services. For these customers, the BPP and the Metering charges are presented as separate line items.

² Customers receiving a consolidated bill under the Company's "CUBS" (Consolidated Utility Billing Service) or under an ESCO's consolidated billing program will not see the definition or the charge on their bills.

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implementation of the unbundled electric bill format in April 2008 should proceed

without undue confusion for customers.

In accordance with the bill display changes discussed above, the Company

developed new sample formats for full-service bills to be issued to residential electric and

residential dual-service customers and to electric demand-billed single service and dual-

service, under 50 kW and over 50 kW, customers beginning April 2008. A copy of each

format is enclosed with this letter. Rebecca Lynch, head of Con Edison's Bill Redesign
