NOTICE OF CHANGE IN RATE SCHEDULE

On December 7, 2006, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation filed with the Public Service Commission of the State of New York amendments of its rate schedule P.S.C. No. 12 - Gas proposing to adopt a "partial slice of system" approach by which upstream pipeline capacity will be released to retail suppliers who select to take assignment of the Company's primary delivery point capacity. The Company will release a pro rate portion or "slice" of applicable firm pipeline capacity in the Company's portfolio to retail suppliers, who will pay the applicable pipelines directly. The Company also proposes to include an adjustment, for the difference between the system weighted average cost of capacity and the weighted average cost of capacity associated with the pipeline capacity released through the Retail Access Program, in the Transportation Demand Adjustment, which is billed to all customers taking service under the Retail Access Program.

Notice of Proposed Changes to the Schedule for Electric Service of Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc.

Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc (the "Company") filed with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") proposed changes to its senedule for electric service, P.S.C. No. 2 - ELECTRICITY ("Electronic ariff").

The proposed changes modify the Charges for Municipal Undergrounding section of the Company's Electric Tariff. This section addresses municipal requests or requirements for the Company to relocate underground all or a portion of its existing overhead distribution or transmission facilities within the municipality. This section provides framework for addressing such requests through the implementation of municipality-specific surcharges to recover the costs of undergrounding from those customers located in the municipality making the request.

The proposed changes provide the Company with greater flexibility in the determination of the surcharge and in the timing of its implementation. The changes permit the Company, upon written agreement of the Company and the municipality, to a) defer implementation of the surcharge; and b) defer collection of a portion of the surcharge. In cases of such deferred implementation or deferred collection, interest will be accrued on the deferred amounts. Accrued interest will be added to the Incremental Capital Costs and the surcharge shall be recalculated.

The filing, which is subject to Commission review and approval, is proposed to become effective April 1, 2007. Details of the above changes may be examined at the office of the PSC or in any of the Company's offices where applications for service may be made.
