NOTICE OF COLLABORATIVE MEETING OF THE
INDIAN POINT CLOSURE TASK FORCE

(Issued May 9, 2017)

On February 28, 2017, Governor Andrew M. Cuomo announced the creation of a task force to provide guidance and support to the communities, taxing jurisdictions, and employees affected by the planned closure of Indian Point. The Department of Public Service was called upon to lead the Task Force, which is charged with developing recommendations to mitigate local tax and workforce impacts, evaluating and identifying new economic opportunities and work force retraining programs and opportunities, advocating for appropriate decommissioning timelines in the best interests of local communities, and ultimately positioning the region for a prosperous and sustainable future.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the first meeting of the Task Force will be held on Wednesday, May 31, 2017 beginning at 7:00 p.m. at the Cortlandt Town Hall, 1 Heady Street, Cortlandt, NY 10567. Members of the public are welcome to attend.

Topics of the meeting will include: the scope and goals of the Task Force, and presentations regarding key issues related to the closure agreement.
