to Reforming the Energy Vision.

NOTICE OF ADDITIONAL PUBLIC STATEMENT HEARINGS

(Issued January 28, 2015)

The Secretary of the New York State Public Service Commission (Commission) issued Notices of Public Statement Hearings on January 7, 2015 and January 26, 2015, announcing hearings to be held at six locations across the state concerning the Reforming the Energy Vision (REV) proceeding. Additional Public Statement Hearing will also be held in the Cities of Rochester and Binghamton. The hearings will give members of the public an opportunity to be heard concerning the August 22, 2014 straw proposal issued by the Staff of the New York State Department of Public Service (Staff) entitled "Developing the REV Market in New York: DPS Staff Straw Proposal on Track One Issues." The straw proposal made recommendations that the Commission will be considering in the context of this proceeding, designed to align electric utility practices and the Commission's regulation with technological advances that have created alternate ways to meet electricity demand. The Commission is considering a new business model for energy service providers where distributed energy resources -- such as distributed generation, storage, energy efficiency and demand response -- become a primary tool in the planning and operation of the electric system. Parties to the proceeding have filed comments and reply comments on the straw proposal, and hundreds of individuals have filed public comments through the Commission's website.

In the hour prior to each Public Statement Hearing, representatives from Staff will present an information session on what the REV initiative means for customers and be available to answer questions. Each information session will be immediately followed by a hearing where all those wishing to comment on REV and the straw proposal will have an opportunity to make a statement on the record. It is not necessary to be present at the start of the hearing, to make an appointment in advance, or to present written material to speak at the hearing. Persons will be called to speak after completing a request card. Each public statement hearing will continue until everyone wishing to speak has been heard or other reasonable arrangements have been made. A verbatim transcript of the hearings will be included in the record of these proceedings and will be posted on the Commission's website.

All comments will become part of the record considered by the Commission.
