RULING GRANTING FURTHER EXTENSION

MICHELLE L. PHILLIPS, Administrative Law Judge:

By ruling issued June 1, 2017, I required New York American Water Company and Suez Water New York Inc. (collectively, the Companies) to file testimony and exhibits that would facilitate the Commission's examination of how their rates would be impacted by a recent change in the definition of Qualified New York Manufacturers. The Companies timely filed the required testimony and exhibits on September 28, 2017.

In order to facilitate the establishment of the future procedural milestones referenced in my June 1 Ruling, I requested scheduling proposals from the Companies and Department of Public Service Staff (Staff). By emails sent on Monday, November 20, 2017, an additional extension of time was requested by Staff to complete its analysis of the Companies' filing and the Companies noted no objection to Staff's request.

Accordingly, I am extending the due date for the submission of either a consensus proposal or separate scheduling proposals to noon on Friday, January 5, 2018.
