NOTICE ESTABLISHING COMMENT AND REPLY SCHEDULE ON THE NEW YORK
STATE ENERGY RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY'S REQUEST FOR
MODIFICATIONS TO THE RENEWABLE PORTFOLIO STANDARD (RPS)

(Issued January 4, 2013)

Please take notice that, on December 14, 2012, in the above captioned proceeding, the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) submitted a petition seeking to modify the Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) Main Tier Program. Specifically, NYSERDA requests that the Commission issue an order revising the rules for the RPS Main Tier in order to limit eligibility to projects located in New York State, including any offshore projects directly interconnected to the New York grid. A Notice of Proposed Rulemaking regarding NYSERDA's petition was published in the State Register on January 2, 2013.

Parties and other stakeholders may submit comments on NYSERDA's December 14, 2012 petition no later than February 19, 2013, and may submit reply comments no later than March 6, 2013. Interested parties and stakeholders may submit comments electronically by e-filing through the Department's Document Matter and Management System (DMM)¹ or to the Secretary at secretary@dps.ny.gov.
