Dear Ms. Gerwitz:

I received your letter dated August 25, 2016 on behalf of the Clean Energy Advisory Council (CEAC) requesting an extension of time to propose energy efficiency metrics and targets, which was directed by the New York State Public Service Commission (Commission) in its *Order Adopting Ratemaking and Utility Revenue Model Policy Framework*, Case 14-M-0101, issued May 19, 2016 (May 2016 REV Order). The Commission directed the CEAC to propose metrics and targets by October 1, 2016.

You state that, in order to effectuate the Commission's directive, the CEAC Steering Committee assigned the task of developing an Energy Efficiency Targets and Metrics Recommendations Report to the CEAC Energy Efficiency Procurement and Markets Working Group. Further, you state that the Energy Efficiency Procurement and Markets Working Group has requested an extension to November 3, 2016 in order to prepare a stronger work product, and to allow time for individual Working Group members to frame their positions for inclusion in the report. You indicated that the Steering Committee supports the requested extension of the report. Ms. Colleen Gerwitz August 31, 2016
