NOTICE REGARDING SUBMISSION OF COMMENTS

(Issued January 12, 2018)

On November 20, 2017, Stop Smart Meters Woodstock NY (SSMWN) filed a Petition for Rescission, In Part, And Modification (Petition) of an Order Granting, In Part, And Denying, In Part, Requests for Modifications Of Opt-Out Tariff (Order), issued October 20, 2017 in this proceeding. Pursuant to the State Administrative Procedure Act (SAPA) §202(1), a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking with respect to the Petition was published in the State Register on December 20, 2017, with comments due on February 5, 2018.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Chapter 455 of the New York Laws of 2017, signed into law on December 13, 2017, increases the minimum period of time for which an agency must accept public comment from 45 to 60 days, effective for all Notices of Proposed Rulemaking published in the State Register on or after October 1, 2017. Therefore, in response to the change in law, comments on the Petition will be accepted until February 20, 2018.
