NOTICE RESCHEDULING HEARING

(Issued February 21, 2013)

On October 17, 2012, the parties to this proceeding, Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (Orange and Rockland) and the Department of Public Service Staff (Staff), successfully concluded negotiations and filed a Joint Proposal, resolving all outstanding issues. This proceeding concerns the petition of Orange and Rockland, pursuant to Public Service Law §113, seeking an allocation to the Company of a portion of the refunds of certain property tax benefits from the Town of Monroe and City of Middletown. By Notice issued November 2, 2012, a hearing previously scheduled to take place on November 8, 2012 was postponed *sine die*, in light of Orange and Rockland's restoration efforts following service disruption occasioned by Hurricane Sandy.

This hearing is now rescheduled to take place by teleconference on March 6, 2013, at 10:00 A.M. The subject of the hearing will be the disposition of refunds suggested in the Joint Proposal.
