RULING REGARDING PRELIMINARY SCOPING STATEMENT

(Issued June 13, 2018)

JAMES COSTELLO, Administrative Law Judge:

On May 29, 2018, Hecate Energy Greene 1 LLC, Hecate Energy Greene 2 LLC, and Hecate Energy Greene County 3 LLC (collectively, Hecate Greene), all wholly-owned subsidiaries of Hecate Energy, LLC, filed a Preliminary Scoping Statement (PSS) in connection with a proposal to construct the Greene County Solar Facility, a 50-megawatt photovoltaic (PV) solar electric generating facility, to be located on approximately 933 acres of leased or purchased private agricultural land in the Town and Village of Coxsackie, Greene County, New York. An updated stakeholder list is attached to the PSS as part of Attachment 2 and as Appendix B. The updated stakeholder list contains, among other things, the names, addresses and, in numerous instances, the phone numbers and email addresses of local residents. PSS and updated stakeholder list are filed and available to the public on the Department of Public Service Document and Matter Management (DMM) system.

On June 7, 2018, a private individual on the stakeholder list filed a complaint that her name, address, phone number and email address are publicly available as part of the

PSS now filed on the DMM system. Accordingly, Hecate Greene is directed to refile the PSS with the phone numbers and email addresses of private individuals redacted. The redacted PSS shall be uploaded to the DMM system by the close of business on Friday, June 15, 2018. The PSS as filed on May 29, 2018 will be locked as confidential on the DMM system upon the filing of the PSS with the redacted information. The May 29, 2018 date will be used in calculating any time periods that run from the date of the filing of the PSS.
