NOTICE SEEKING COMMENT ON JOINT UTILITIES PROPOSED
PRIVACY STANDARD FOR BUILDING ENERGY MANAGEMENT

(Issued September 8, 2017)

As required by the Commission's Order on Distributed System Implementation Plan Filings¹ related to distributed system platform capabilities to achieve Reforming the Energy Vision (REV) goals, the Joint Utilities submitted a filing dated June 7, 2017 proposing building energy management and benchmarking data standards for the Commission's consideration. As discussed in that filing, the Joint Utilities propose a 4/50 privacy standard as the basis for utilities providing whole-building aggregated data to building owners or their authorized agents.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Commission seeks comment on the proposed 4/50 privacy standard and the issues associated with that standard. Interested parties are invited to submit comments by October 10, 2017.
