Below are additional community events at Fort Benning:

- Battle Buddy Resource Center – This food bank operation is managed by volunteers and offers support to soldier families struggling financially. Liberty employees donated groceries during a food drive and Liberty has provided additional support through donations.
- Santa’s Castle – This operation is managed by volunteers and offers support to soldier families struggling to provide Christmas gifts to their children. Liberty has donated funds to this operation and is currently planning to support enhanced fundraising efforts in 2016.
- Survivor Outreach Services – This organization reaches out to families of fallen soldiers and Liberty has provided financial support to assist with Wall of Heroes ceremonies where family members remember and honor the life of their soldier with the mounting of a picture at the SOS center.
- Community Spouses Club – This organization is managed by volunteers who conduct various fundraising events throughout the year that are used to provide student scholarships and community grants to military families and those who impact them. Liberty participated in the fundraising events and also made a financial contribution to fund three general scholarships (Spirit of Liberty Scholarship) and one memorial scholarship to honor the life of CSM Thomas Roy Morgan who was tragically killed in an automobile accident in March 2016.
- National Infantry Museum – Liberty has contributed funds to help operate this facility but has also targeted specific funds to be used for repair and maintenance needs in the museum to include projection equipment used in the galleries as well as repairs needed for the World War II Street exhibit attached to the museum.
- Soldier Transition Support – Liberty has been a key sponsor in soldier transition activities to include active participation in job fairs along with financial support for meals and audio visual equipment.
- Military Awareness & Recognition Programs – Liberty has been a key supporter in a variety of programs, many coordinated through the Greater Columbus, Georgia Chamber of Commerce, where programs impacting Fort Benning are highlighted and where the work and sacrifice of our soldiers are recognized.
- Fort Benning Community Projects – Liberty is constantly on the lookout for projects on post where it can provide support to enhance the quality of life for soldiers, promote the mission of the Army and honor the sacrifice of those who have gone before. On a recent project, Liberty partnered with 130 OCS students to restore a monument field located on post. This involved significant landscaping as well as the cleaning of 12 monument stations on Sacrifice Field. This project was warmly embraced by the fort leadership and actually attracted families on post who came out to assist in the project.

Massachusetts

- For the fifth consecutive year, the American Council for an Energy-Efficient Economy (ACEEE) gave Massachusetts their top ranking based on a strong commitment to energy efficiency under its Green Communities Act. This recognition is for the state and the efforts here are based on the MassSave® program, of which Liberty Utilities is a part.
- In both 2014 and 2015, Liberty Utilities received a Mayoral Citation from the City of Fall River in honor of our efforts in the annual citywide cleanup.
- The Greater Fall River Relay for Life Committee also presented the Massachusetts team with a certificate for “outstanding volunteer” for the extra help the company provided to them for last year’s event (outside of what the registered team did).

- Liberty Utilities' Midstates call center is a finalist for Best in Class Contact Center (under 99 seats), to be awarded in June at the 17th Annual Call Center Week. The finalists are recognized for their superior thinking, creativity and execution within the call center industry.

New Hampshire

- The United States Environmental Protection agency recently awarded Liberty with its 4th consecutive ENERGY STAR® Partner of the Year Award. This award was given to Liberty Utilities and the other NH Core utilities including Eversource, Unitil and the New Hampshire Electric Coop. In 2015, Liberty Utilities alone provided \$6.7 million in incentives to customers who implemented energy efficiency measures.

Corporate

- In the final quarter of 2015, employees were invited to take part in our United Way fundraising campaign by choosing to make a one-time donation or arrange for monthly payroll contributions. Thanks to the generosity of employees across the organization, more than \$75,000 in donations were raised during the time of this fundraising campaign. As a result of this noteworthy achievement, our organization was also awarded a United Way 2015 Spirit Award for "New Workplace Campaign" in February 2016.
