NOTICE OF PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

TAKE NOTICE that Administrative Law Judge Rafael A. Epstein will hold a procedural conference by telephone on Thursday, June 9, 2011, beginning at 1:00 p.m.

This case concerns proposed tariffs filed April 29, 2011 whereby Long Island Water Corporation seeks to increase its annual revenues by \$9.6 million (19.5%). The average annual residential bill would increase about \$86 (17%). The Commission has suspended the proposed tariffs pending a review of the company's application.

The primary purpose of the June 9 conference is to identify interested parties and establish a procedural schedule. The conference will not be transcribed. Before June 9, a call-in number will be provided to all persons that have indicated an interest in becoming parties to the proceeding.
