ERRATA NOTICE AND CLARIFICATION

(Issued June 1, 2012)

This Errata Notice and Clarification concerns the Commission's Order, issued May 24, 2012, in the above-referenced case, directing telecommunications carriers to file tariff revisions and supporting documentation.

First, the FCC is allowing interstate access tariff filings for 2012 to take effect on July 3 rather than July 1. If the FCC clarifies that intrastate access tariffs are likewise able to take effect on July 3, we will allow that effective date without further notice to carriers.

Second, Verizon New York Inc. has informed Department Staff that a minor error has resulted in a change to their Transitional Terminating Access Charge rate. The rate, previously reported to be \$0.012446 will instead be \$0.012409.

Third, on Page 4 of the Order, line 11 that reads "to \$2.00/month by the fourth year, to make up some of the lost access charge revenue" should read "up to \$3.00/month by the sixth year for residential and single-line business customers, and up to \$6.00/month for multi-line business customers, to make up some of the lost access charge revenue."

Fourth, on Page 7 of the Order, line 27, the word "lower" should be "higher."
