Quick question, will the REF*5E APP Status in the 814C only be used to notify the ESCO that the customer is no longer eligible for APP benefits? That's the note on usage in the 814C IG and if that's the case the only possible value listed should be "N" but the IG lists both "N" and "Y" as possible values.
