On behalf of Laser Northeast Gathering Company, LLC and DMP New York, Inc., Williams Field Services Company, LLC ("Williams") submits this preliminary response to your letter of April 26, 2013 in the captioned proceeding. In that letter, you informed Williams that any relief from Certificate Ordering Condition 1.(s2) should be contained in a petition to the Commission for an amendment to the issued Article VII Certificate pursuant to Public Service Law 122(4). After consultation with the Department of Public Service Staff, it appears reasonable and logical that Williams should first meet with Town of Windsor representatives, as we proposed in our letter to the Secretary, dated April 25, 2013. As stated in that letter, Williams will then submit the results of that meeting to the Secretary and we will propose a schedule for any necessary corrective measures, including the possibility of petitioning for an amendment to the Certificate, as well as any comments we may have on the Town's April 16, 2013 letter. By submitting this preliminary response to the Secretary's letter of April 26, 2013, Williams is not waiving any positions or arguments it may assert in later submissions or in any forums.
