
I would like to provide you with an update on the status of the Cape Vincent wind project being developed by Cape Vincent Wind Power, LLC.

BP Wind Energy is actively seeking to divest its entire development portfolio to potential buyers that have the strategy and resources to continue to develop these projects. The portfolio includes Cape Vincent Wind Power, LLC and the Cape Vincent wind project, and we currently anticipate that the sale transactions will close by year-end.

All decisions regarding the Article 10 Application and the filing thereof for the Cape Vincent wind project will be made by the new owner of the project. Similarly, formal stipulations will be finalized by the new owner of the project, although we continue to advance the project during the divestment process.

We will provide a status update when further information is available.
