NOTICE OF NEW CASE NUMBERS RELATING TO
UTILITY REVENUE REFORMS

(Issued August 9, 2016)

In its Order Adopting A Ratemaking and Utility Revenue Model Policy Framework, issued May 19, 2016,¹ the Commission directed the State's major investor-owned electric utilities owning transmission and distribution facilities to file reform proposals regarding Platform Service Revenues, Earning Adjustment Mechanisms (EAMs), Scorecards, Clawback proposals, and Aggregated Data access requirements. Interconnection survey process and interconnection EAMs are due September 2, 2016.²

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that two new cases are hereby established to facilitate the tracking of proposals relating to ratemaking reforms. First, all filings related to Platform Service Revenues, which are subject to a unique compliance regime, and Aggregated Data access requirements will be filed in Case 16-M-0428, entitled "In the Matter of Utility Platform

Service Revenues and Aggregated Data Access Reforms Supporting the Commission's Reforming the Energy Vision." Second, EAMs and Scorecards shall be filed in Case 16-M-0429, entitled "In the Matter of Earnings Adjustment Mechanism and Scorecard Reforms Supporting the Commission's Reforming the Energy Vision." Clawback reforms will be dealt with on a utility by utility basis in each utility's respective rate case.

By separate notice a new case is also being established to facilitate the tracking of rate design reform proposals.³
