For example, we recently attended both the Somerset and Yates Town Board meetings in October whereby we provided an update regarding the Project and discussed the upcoming filing of the PSS. The PSS is designed to gather input from the public and interested agencies on the scope and methodology of studies to be conducted in support of the final Application for the Project, which will be filed at a later date.

The filing of this PSS on Thursday, November 18 will start a 21 day comment period. During this time any person, agency or municipality may submit comments on the PSS by serving them on Lighthouse Wind at 310 4<sup>th</sup> Street NE, Suite 200, Charlottesville, VA, 22902, and filing a copy with the Secretary of the Department of Public Service. Lighthouse Wind will then prepare a summary of such comments and make a reply within 21 days of the comment period ending. 




