# Call to make thief a transit authority

The lawyer for a serial transit thief who was busted this week for taking a Greyhound bus for a joy ride insisted on Thursday that her client is an "excellent driver" — and the city should hire him as a security consultant.

Sally Butler, who is representing transit nut Darius McCollum, said he has actually helped the state, FBI and NYPD by pointing out security flaws in the city's transportation system.

"He walked with them through the system, showing them where things were vulnerable. And obviously, he still knows them," Butler said outside Brooklyn Criminal Court,

where McCollum was awaiting arraignment in his latest vehicle heist.

"If anyone can walk up in Port Authority and steal a bus, do you think we need some assistance?"

Butler has represented McCollum, who has

Asperger's syndrome, in many of his 29 other arrests for transit-related thefts.

The bus- and subway-obsessed man was busted again Wednesday for allegedly swiping a bus from the Port Authority Bus Terminal and driving it through Brooklyn before getting caught.

"The city should be embarrassed if these allegations are true. Shame on them," Butler said. "What if they acknowledge what skill he has and utilize it?"

"Here's a guy that obviously they need some help from, and instead, he's going to be sitting in Rikers Island for a couple years wasting everyone's money."

## 'Abusive' cult leader on trial

LONDON — The leader of a Maoist cult went on trial in London on Thursday, accused of imprisoning and sexually assaulting his followers and abusing his own daughter in a secretive

commune for 30 years.

Prosecutors said Aravindan Balakrishnan, 75, known as "Comrade Bala," was a charismatic man who brainwashed his followers and led a small radical communist

group in London in the 1970s.

They charged the group's membership soon dwindled to just six women, who were led to fear Balakrishnan as an "all powerful and all-seeing" figure. *AP*





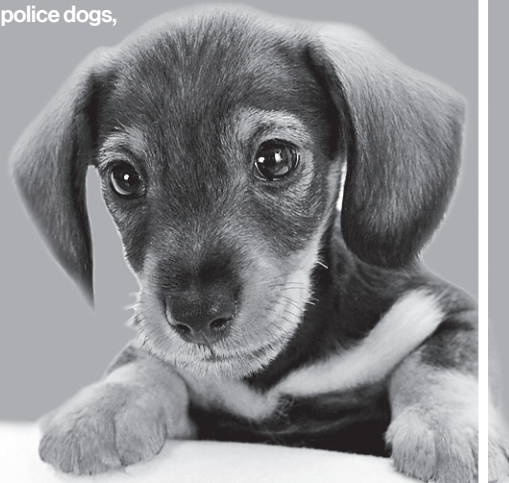
