NOTICE OF TECHNICAL CONFERENCE

(Issued April 29, 2013)

Please take notice that a technical conference open to the public has been scheduled for 10:30 a.m. on Tuesday, May 14, 2013, in the 19th floor Board Room of the Commission's Albany Offices, 3 Empire State Plaza, Albany, New York. In its Order Establishing Procedures for Joint Review Under Article VII of the Public Service Law and Approving Rule Changes issued April 22, 2013, in Case 12-T-0502 ("the April Order"), the Commission established procedures for a comparative evaluation on a common record of proposed AC project applications to be filed pursuant to Article VII of the Public Service Law. It also adopted modifications to the Article VII implementing regulations, and outlined additional steps that it will take in the coming months.

The Commission directed Department of Public Service (DPS) Staff to host a technical conference to discuss the process with potential applicants and other interested parties and to answer their questions. The conference will begin with a presentation by DPS Staff explaining the process set out in the April Order. Thereafter, conference attendees will be afforded an opportunity to ask questions of the presenters. Interested parties are encouraged to submit any questions or suggested language changes to the Article VII regulations that would streamline the Commission's process by email in advance of the conference to the following mailbox address:
