
Dear Messrs. Harris, Rigo and Chandler:

Cape Vincent Wind Power, LLC (CVWP) submitted its final Public Involvement Program (PIP) relating to its proposed wind farm, the Cape Vincent Wind Farm, on November 16, 2012. The Cape Vincent Wind Farm facility location as indicated in the PIP is based on mapping that, only when adjusted for a cartographic registration problem and scrutinized extremely closely, indicates that an additional municipality is directly affected by the project "as proposed or in any alternative location." The PIP must be amended to include consultation with

the Village of Chaumont as a directly affected stakeholder, since the electric interconnection facilities indicated on the Project Map includes an alignment that would be located within the bounds of the Village of Chaumont along Jefferson County Route 179. Such consultation should address the matters outlined in the PIP and the relevant regulations at 16 NYCRR 1000.4. An amendment to the PIP including such outreach to the Village of Chaumont shall be submitted to me within 15 days.
