RULING GRANTING EXTENSION

Administrative Law Judge:

By ruling issued June 1, 2017, I required New York American Water Company and Suez Water New York Inc. (collectively, the Companies) to file testimony and exhibits that would facilitate the Commission's examination of how their rates would be impacted by a recent change in the definition of Qualified New York Manufacturers.

By letter dated June 15, 2017, the Companies requested a 90-day extension of the filing deadline. The Companies provided several reasons why such an extension would be appropriate. Accordingly, the requested extension is granted.

The testimony and exhibits, as described in the June 1 Ruling, are due September 28, 2017. Future procedural milestones will be considered after the required filings have been reviewed.
