**Roadway Crossings and Highway Work Permits**

## PURPOSE

This appendix identifies the Highway Work Permits and Use and Occupancy Permits for the highway and road crossings associated with Segment III of the RARP. Segment III of the Project includes the construction of (a) a new 345/115 kV air-insulated RG&E substation (Station 255), (b) a new 345 kV RG&E transmission line between Station 255 and existing RG&E Station 80 (Circuit 40), and (c) new 115 kV RG&E transmission lines (Circuit 940 and Circuit 941) from Station 255 to Structure #39 located along the Rochester & Southern Railroad right-of-way (ROW).

The following additional Project elements are necessary or beneficial to accomplish the above Project objectives: a portion of existing RG&E Circuit 906 will be relocated to the eastern edge of the Rochester & Southern Railroad corridor to vacate the existing ROW for Circuits 940 and 941.

Copies of the permits are not included in this appendix as the various transportation agencies will not actually issue permits until documentation has been submitted demonstrating that construction contractors and subcontractors have the required insurance coverage. Insurance documentation cannot be submitted to the transportation agencies until RG&E has completed the procurement process has selected the construction contractors. A summary of meetings and communications with the various transportation agencies demonstrating RG&E's efforts at working closely with the various transportation agencies is attached to this appendix.

*8. a) The Certificate Holder shall coordinate all work performed at state and municipal road and highway crossings with the appropriate state and municipal officials and shall obtain the required permits for such work, subject to the Commission's ongoing jurisdiction as appropriate.  
b) The Certificate Holder shall coordinate with the appropriate municipal agencies and police departments for traffic management of roads under municipal jurisdiction.  
c) A copy of each permit or approval received from the issuing agencies shall be provided to the Secretary by the Certificate Holder promptly after receipt by the Certificate Holder of such permit or approval and before commencement of construction across any affected area.*

*73. The Certificate Holder shall coordinate all State Highway crossings and longitudinal occupations with NYSDOT. The Certificate Holder shall obtain the necessary permits from NYSDOT, including, as appropriate, a Highway Work Permit and Use and Occupancy Permit pursuant to 17 NYCRR Part 131, including, if necessary, the filing by NYSDOT of a request with the Federal Highway Administration for an exception to the Accommodation Plan for Longitudinal Use of Freeway Right-of-Way by Utilities, for the construction, operation and maintenance of the Project in the right-of-way of State highways. Said Use and Occupancy Permit shall include payment of a fair market value-based fee for use of State property.*

## HIGHWAY WORK PERMITS

### Segment III - Transmission Lines: Highway Work Permits

Table I-1 and Table I-2 list the State and County road crossings identified on the P&P drawings in Appendix A. The existing Circuit 906 currently crosses Krenzer Road in the Town of Chili and as such a new crossing permit is not required for the slight realignment of this circuit.

Jerry,

1. Monumentation must be checked by the County Surveyor. Please email site plans to the County Surveyor at [gregorybly@monroecounty.gov](mailto:gregorybly@monroecounty.gov). A security deposit of \$2500.00 and a survey report may be required to protect any monumentation located in or near the work area.
2. Show the right-of-way width and label E River Rd "County Road 84".
3. A tie distance to the nearest county or state highway (Lehigh Station Rd) is required for location purposes.
4. Label adjacent property addresses (owner, address, tax account #).
5. A standard County drainage note is required. "Highway drainage along the County highway must be maintained. The applicant will be responsible for all required grading in the County right-of-way. The owner will place a culvert and/or storm sewer of a type and size determined by the Monroe County Director of Transportation."
6. Show the design speed limit and intersection sight distances (required and provided) to the left and right.
7. Show driveway width.
8. A standard County highway permit note is required. "After MCDOT approves this project, a 136 Highway Permit and a 239F Permit will be required. Inspection of all construction in the right-of-way will be a condition of these permits."
9. A standard County materials note is required. "All materials installed in the County right-of-way shall be in accordance with the MCDOT Standards and Details in effect when installed."
10. Show MCDOT Figure(s) DRIVEWAY WITH CULVERT on the plans. Electronic versions (PDF and DWG formats) are available on MCDOT's web site: <http://www.monroecounty.gov/dot-standarddetails.php>.
11. The maximum allowable plans sheet size for MCDOT Permits is 22" x 34" (when submitting full size plans).
12. Show a location sketch map.
13. A review fee of \$150.00 is due to continue our review/approval of this project. Please make checks payable to "Director of Finance, County of Monroe".
