## Case No. 12-M-0476 et. al. EDI Business/Technical Working Groups Accelerated Switching Implementation Workpaper – 1/16/2015

## Questions for utilities:

- 1. The implementation, based upon the Ordering Clause 3 of ORDER AUTHORIZING ACCELERATED SWITCH OF COMMODITY SUPPLIERS, Issued and Effective December 15, 2014 appears to be Friday, February 13, 2015 is this correct?
  - a. What is the last date that and cutoff time that each utility will process under the prior 15 calendar rule?
- 2. Generally, for each utility, what is the cutoff time for EDI Transactions to be received in order to be processed in that night's batch?
- 3. Enrollment Cancelation Rules
  - a. Confirm that a standard drop, with reason code B38, will effectuate a cancel enrollment if received in time.
  - b. What is the cutoff day for a drop to be sent in order to effectuate a cancel enrollment (i.e., can it be sent the same day of the scheduled meter read date, or must it be the day prior, etc.)?
- 4. Can the incumbent ESCO cancel a drop, i.e. is the Reinstatement transaction still valid?
- 5. What is the cutoff day for a drop to be sent in order to be effective on the next scheduled read date?
  - a. Electric Is it the day before the scheduled read date?
  - b. Gas For those utilities that serve by calendar month, is it the last day of the prior month?
- 6. Will the accelerated enrollment changes have any impact upon billing? If so, please explain.
