Re: Case 18-C-0396 – Joint Petition of T-Mobile USA, Inc. and Sprint Communications Company L.P. Concerning an Indirect Transfer of Control Pursuant to Sections 99(2) and 100 of Public Service Law.

Dear Mr. Wilson,

I received your petition, filed on July 6, 2018, pursuant to Section 100 and subsequently an amendment letter filed on July 26, 2018 to include Section 99(2) of the Public Service Law (PSL), requesting approval of an indirect transfer of control in which Sprint Communications Company L.P. becomes an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of T-Mobile USA, Inc.

According to PSL Sections 99(2) and 100 an application is deemed approved within ninety (90) days unless the Commission or its designee notifies the petitioner in writing that the public interest requires the Commission's review and its written order. The Director of the Office of Telecommunications has been designated by the Commission to review such petitions under Sections 99(2) and 100.

A preliminary review of the petition indicates that the public interest requires a detailed Commission review of the petition. Therefore, Pursuant to Public Service Law Sections 99(2) and 100, I am informing you that the Commission will review your Petition and will issue a written response in this proceeding.
