We are writing to update you on NYSEG's proposed Seneca West Pipeline Interconnect Project, a 5-mile (approximately) natural gas transmission pipeline from Inergy's Seneca Lake Gas Storage West Pipeline, west of Upson Road in the Town of Big Flats, through the Town of Horseheads to our proposed metering and regulating station at Gardner Road in the Village of Horseheads. This project will increase the reliability of natural gas supply in the Elmira area and help us to continue to provide natural gas at competitive prices.

The proposed project remains under review by the Public Service Commission (PSC); approval is anticipated early next year. We cannot begin construction work until the PSC has completed its review and approves the project, however, we are permitted to continue to plan and make preparations for construction while the project is under review. As part of this planning and preparation work, you may notice some activity along the project area on or about December 6 and 7, as we will be conducting a field review of the project with potential contractors. The field reviews will be conducted from public roads; we will not be going off the existing road rights of way and onto private property during our visits.
