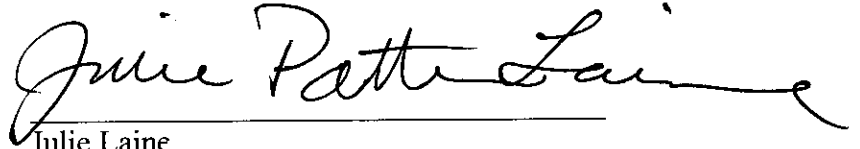
Dear Secretary Brillling:
