Notice of Further Suspension of
Effective Date of Major Rate Changes

TO: Long Island Water Corporation, d/b/a Long Island American Water

FROM: Secretary to the Commission

SUBJECT: Case 11-W-0200 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Rates, Charges, Rules and Regulations for Long Island Water Corporation, d/b/a Long Island American Water.

RECOMMENDATION: Further Suspension of the Effective Date of Major Rate Changes.

On April 29, 2011, Long Island Water Corporation, d/b/a Long Island American Water (LIAW or the Company) filed amendments to its tariff schedule, P.S.C. No. 1 – Water, which would produce an annual base rate increase of about \$9,563,146 or 19.49% for the rate year ending March 31, 2013. By notice issued May 11, 2011, the Commission suspended the proposed revisions through September 27, 2011. The investigation in this proceeding is continuing.

The Public Service Commission delegated its authority to suspend the effective date of amendments to a tariff schedule to the Secretary to the Commission. Accordingly, pending the conclusion of this proceeding and decision on the proposed changes, the operation of the amendments listed in the May 11, 2011 notice is further suspended and the use of the rates, charges, rules and regulations contained therein is deferred through March 27, 2012, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

The rates, charges, rules, and regulations altered by the suspended amendments shall continue in effect until this proceeding is concluded or until the period of further suspension and any extended suspension expires, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

Long Island Water Corporation, d/b/a Long Island American Water is directed to file with this Commission not later than September 22, 2011, a consecutively numbered supplement announcing suspension of the amendments.
