NOTICE OF PUBLIC STATEMENT HEARINGS AND REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON
NEW YORK STATE ELECTRIC AND GAS CORPORATION PROPOSAL TO BUILD
NATURAL GAS PIPELINE IN BIG FLATS AND HORSEHEADS, NEW YORK

(Case 11-T-0654)

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Public Service Commission seeks public comment on an application by New York State Electric and Gas Corporation (NYSE&G) for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need, under Article VII of the Public Service Law, to build a 4.9-mile-long eight-inch diameter natural gas pipeline and associated above-ground facilities in the Towns of Big Flats and Horseheads, Chemung County, New York. The pipeline will extend from Inergy's Seneca Lake Gas Storage Facility West Pipeline near the intersection of Yawger Road and Upton Road in the Town of Big Flats to connect with NYSE&G's distribution system at Gardner Road, just west of Westinghouse Road, in the Village of Horseheads. Associated facilities include metering and pressure regulating stations near either end of the proposed pipeline.

As part of the comment process, the Commission will hold public statement hearings. The hearings will give interested members of the public an opportunity to state their views personally before an Administrative Law Judge assigned to the case. A court stenographer will make a word-for-word transcript of the hearings, which will become part of the record of the proceeding.

Staff of the Department of Public Service will conduct a short informational session before each public statement hearing, to describe the Article VII process and answer questions about it. Representatives of NYSE&G will also be

invited to the information sessions, to be available to provide information about its proposed project and respond to questions.

You do not have to be present at the start of a public statement hearing or make an appointment in advance in order to speak. If you wish to speak, you can fill out a very brief request card when you arrive at the hearing. Speakers will be called in the order in which they turn in request cards. **You** do not have to provide a written copy of your comments, but you may if you wish.

Each public statement hearing will be held open for a minimum of one hour. The afternoon hearing will close no later than 5:00 p.m. The evening hearing will remain open until 9:30 p.m., if necessary to hear people who wish to speak. If not all of those who wish to speak have been heard by that time, the administrative law judge will make other reasonable arrangements to include their comments in the record.

Other Ways to Comment

If you cannot attend or prefer not to speak at a public statement hearing, there are several other ways to comment about this case to the Commission.

Writing: You may submit written comments through the Department of Public Service website or by e-mail. Toll-Free Opinion Line: You may also comment orally, by calling the Commission's Opinion Line at 1-800-335-2120. This number is set up to take comments about pending cases from in-State callers, 24 hours a day. Callers should press "1" to leave comments and should refer to "Case 11-T-0654 - NYSE&G - Big Flats to Horseheads Natural Gas Pipeline."

Comments provided through any of these alternative methods must be submitted, or mailed and postmarked, no later than Wednesday, May 2, 2012. Written comments, and summaries of telephone comments, will become part of the record that the Commission will consider in this case. You can view all comments submitted electronically or in writing -- as well as transcripts of the public statement hearings, when completed --
