

Dear Examiners and Siting Board,

Please find the enclosed statement and signatures of equestrians and equestrian club members, OPPOSED to the Cassadaga Wind Project.

A major component of our County's 20/20 plan was the generous grant funding of \$298,000 from the Appalachian Regional Commission, along with meticulous guidance from the DEC, and hard work from dedicated volunteers, to develop an absolutely breathtaking network of equestrian trails, throughout Cherry Creek and Charlotte . Unbelievably, Everpower's turbine map depicts 7-8 turbines in extremely close proximity to the trails.

Everpower's Shadow Flicker Analysis states there will be flicker over the Equestrian, Earl Cardot and Snowmobile trails.

The British Horse Society [more wind turbine experienced], published their survey of equestrians and wind turbine encounters. The responses detailed many incidents of spooked horses, resulting in injuries to both horse and rider. Some horses responded in panic with turbines over 1 mile away. Horses react to the noise, shadows, movement of the blades and unfamiliar sights. It is hard to predict how a horse might behave until the actual encounter-by then it is too late.

Equestrians should be able to safely use and enjoy our trails. They should not be put at undue risk of injury or even deadly accidents, due to a frightened, out of control horse from wind turbines. Everpower was fully aware of our trail system, prior to designing the turbine layout, but chose to site them where they will be problematic and potentially dangerous. This is unacceptable.

Please do not approve this project !!!
