NOTICE OF PROCEDURAL AND TECHNICAL CONFERENCE

(Issued February 8, 2013)

TAKE NOTICE that a procedural conference, followed by a technical conference, will be held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Paul Agresta on Monday, March 11, 2013, in the Public Service Commission's New York City offices, 90 Church Street, New York, New York, 4th Floor, Boardroom. The procedural conference will begin at 10:30 a.m. and will be followed immediately by the technical conference. Questions about the conferences may be directed to ALJ Paul Agresta at (518) 474-6436.

The purpose of the procedural conference is to identify parties and major issues, to establish a schedule for the proceeding and to address issues related to the service of documents, discovery and any other procedural matters identified by the parties at the conference. Parties are urged to confer in advance on proposed schedules in an effort to achieve a consensus.

The technical conference will consist of an overview of the rate filings to be presented by representatives of Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (Con Edison), followed by an opportunity for the other parties to ask questions. The presentation should identify all major cost drivers underlying the proposed changes in rates; significant capital expenditure initiatives; important changes to tariff rules and accounting practices or other policies and procedures; new program initiatives; and any proposals or information intended to be responsive to recent Commission directives or policies.

The technical conference is a discovery opportunity, not an evidentiary hearing. The questions of the Parties should be aimed at better understanding Con Edison's proposals and the underlying data, not at testing the accuracy or validity of positions.

Those interested in becoming a party to the proceeding are encouraged to become a registered user of the Public Service Commission's Document and Matter Management (DMM) System and to submit their request for party status through the DMM system.
