NOTICE EXTENDING DEADLINE TO FILE COMMENTS

(Issued February 2, 2016)

On January 29, 2016, Citizens for Local Power ("CLP"), and on February 1, 2016, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc., Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY, KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a National Grid, and Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid, New York State Electric & Gas Corporation, and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (together, the "Joint Utilities") requested an extension of the deadline to submit comments on the Technical Conference Regarding Customer and Aggregated Energy Data Provision and Related Issues held January 28 and 29, 2016. Comments are due February 5, 2016.

CLP states that the Technical Conference raised many critical questions and provided new information about the type and amount of data required for third parties seeking to provide services to customers, including municipalities that seek to introduce Community Choice Aggregation. CLP requests an extension until February 15, 2016 to file comments due to, among other reasons, the fact that the transcript of the Technical Conference is not yet available. CLP is concerned that the

period between the availability of the transcripts and the deadline is insufficient to fully consider and respond to the questions and recommendations raised at the Technical Conference.

Joint Utilities requests an extension until February 19, 2016 on a similar basis to CLP, i.e. the transcript of the Technical Conference is not yet available. Joint Utilities states that stakeholders will not have the opportunity to review all of the comments and presentations from the Technical Conference. In addition, the questions set forth in the Notice and the issues addressed at the Technical Conference require thoughtful and careful review.

This is to advise that I am granting an extension to all parties to February 19, 2016 to file comments on the Technical Conference Regarding Customer and Aggregated Energy Data Provision and Related Issues. This extension is granted in order to promote the fair, orderly and efficient conduct of this proceeding.
