NOTICE SOLICITING COMMENTS ON STAFF PROPOSAL

(Issued June 11, 2018)

On March 29, 2018, Department of Public Service Staff (Staff) filed its Staff Proposal to Address the Accounting and Ratemaking of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 (Proposal), as directed by the Commission in the above captioned case.¹ The Proposal recommends that, for utilities that cannot incorporate the Act's changes into their current rate plans, the Commission requires tariff filings implementing a sur-credit to be effective October 1, 2018, to ensure all savings from the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 (Act) are returned to ratepayers.
