The purpose of Day One of the Technical Conference will be for the designated Trial Staff of the Department of Public Service to present, explain and discuss a Report and Motion it has prepared and submitted in advance of the Technical Conference, and for the parties to pose questions of the presenters and to otherwise discuss the Report and Motion and its implications in these proceedings.

In response to a request made by Scenic Hudson, Inc., on behalf of the Hudson Valley Smart Energy Coalition ("HVSEC"), Staff has agreed to permit HVSEC to present the HVSEC Report as to the "need" for any transmission line and environmental impact. Therefore, the purpose of Day Two of the Technical

Conference will be for HVSEC to present, explain and discuss the HVSEC Report, and for the parties to pose questions of the presenters and to otherwise discuss the HVSEC Report and its implications in these proceedings. The deadline for submission of the HVSEC Report shall be the same as for the Trial Staff report and Motion. Day Two may also provide an opportunity to continue or follow-up on Day One matters.

The purpose of Day Three of the Technical Conference will be for all parties to pose additional follow-up questions to the presenters and to otherwise continue their technical discussions in these proceedings.

The purpose of the Technical Conference is for experts to exchange complex information in a collegial manner. There will not be an opportunity for the public to provide comments or ask questions during the conference; however, there will be limited seating available for interested persons to observe. Given limited table seating capacity, priority for table seating will be given to those who are parties or representatives.
