RULING GRANTING DELAY

Administrative Law Judge:

In a previous ruling, I requested the submission of scheduling proposals from New York American Water Company and Suez Water New York Inc. (collectively, the Companies) and Department of Public Service Staff (Staff). By email dated January 5th, Staff requested that any further action in this proceeding be delayed, pending the resolution of Case 17-M-0815, a recently instituted proceeding addressing the impact on NYS utilities of recent changes to the federal tax law.¹ The Companies do not oppose Staff's request.

The impacts of the changes being studied in Case 17-M-0815 are expected to offset the impact of the changes being reviewed in this proceeding. Accordingly, the submission of scheduling proposals in this case will be delayed, with a new submission date to be set by separate ruling issued after Case 17-M-0815 is resolved.
