CASE 05-S-1376 - Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Rates, Charges, Rules and Regulations of Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. for Steam Service.

RULING ON PARTY STATUS

(Issued March 14, 2006)

ROBERT R. GARLIN, Administrative Law Judge:

The Public Service Commission's rules of procedure provide that permission to intervene in a Commission proceeding "will be granted if the intervention is likely to contribute to the development of a complete record or is otherwise fair and in the public interest."¹

A request to intervene has been received from the Pace Energy Project (Pace). Pace states that it has participated in a number of proceedings relating to the development of combined heat and power plants in New York State. Pace goes on to state that it intends to address rate design issues in this proceeding that could affect the development of combined heat and power plants in Consolidated Edison Company's service territory.

Pace has demonstrated sufficient interest in the issues in this proceeding, and its request to intervene is granted. An updated list of the parties to this proceeding will be posted shortly on the Commission's web site.²
