Dear Secretary Burgess:

Enclosed with this letter, in the form and number prescribed by Section 1000.6(a) of the regulations of the Board on Electric Generation Siting and the Environment (Siting Board), is the application of Alle-Catt Wind Energy LLC (ACWE) for authority pursuant to Public Service Law Article 10 to build and operate the Alle-Catt Wind Farm, a 340 MW wind-powered electric generation facility project located in the Towns of Centerville and Rushford in Allegany County, the Towns of Farmersville and Freedom in Cattaraugus County and the Town of Arcade in Wyoming County, New York (Application).

ACWE will shortly file an application with the United States Army Corps of Engineers (US ACOE) for a Clean Water Act permit to conduct activities in waters of the United States. At that time, ACWE will file with the Siting Board an application for a Water Quality Certificate together with a copy of its US ACOE application as required by 16 NYCRR § 1000.8(a).

Prior Filings

On May 15, 2017, ACWE submitted a Public Involvement Plan (PIP), a revised and updated version on July 25, 2017, and a second revision on August 17, 2017. On January 5, 2018, ACWE submitted a Preliminary Scoping Statement (PSS). A revised PSS was filed on January 22, 2018, with supplements filed on January 22, 2018 and January 25, 2018, notice of which was published in *The Patriot and Free Press* (Cuba Patriot) on December 27, 2017 and in the *Arcade Herald* on December 20, 2017 and republished in the *Arcade Herald* on January 18, 2018.

On March 20, 2018, a pre-application conference was conducted in Delevan, New York by Administrative Law Judge Dakin Lecakes of the Department of Public Service and Administrative Law Judge Michael Caruso of the Department of Environmental Conservation.

A Notice of Commencement of Stipulation Consultations was served on the active parties on May 18, 2018. Confidential stipulation conferences were held between June 21, 2018 and September 4, 2018 and draft stipulations and related comments were exchanged among the parties through November 13, 2018. Although ACWE elected not to pursue the execution of stipulations, the conferences have been very helpful in identifying issues of particular concern to participants and shaping the contents of the Application.

Application Contents

The enclosed Application has been prepared in compliance with Part 1001 and served in Compliance with Section 1000.6 of the Siting Board regulations.

The Application is comprised of seven bound books. Book 1 includes the text of the exhibits prescribed in Part 1001 and the pre-filed testimony of the sponsoring witnesses, including ACWE's Proposed Certificate Conditions with explanatory testimony. The testimony identifies the witness, his or her education and professional experience, and the exhibit, exhibits or parts thereof for which he or she is responsible. Book 2 contains all figures – maps and drawings – associated with the exhibits other than those included in Books 6 and 7. Books 3 and 4 include technical appendices, which have been summarized or referenced in the exhibits. Book 5 includes Exhibit 24 and the Visual Impact Assessment. Book 6 includes Site Plans and Book 7, wetland impact drawings and tabulations.

Certain information included in the Application constitutes trade secrets, confidential commercial information and confidential critical infrastructure information, which ACWE is requesting not be included in the Siting Board's public files. A copy of that request is attached.

Also enclosed is a check in the amount of \$340,000.00 for the fee required by Public Service Law Section 164(6)(a).

Public Notice and Document Availability

Notice of the Application submittal has been given to the persons and entities as required by Section 1000.7 and published in the *Arcade Herald* on December 6, 2018 and *Patriot and Free Press* (Cuba Patriot) on December 12, 2018. A copy of the notice and list of recipients is attached hereto. An affidavit of service will be included with the submittal letter posted on the Department of Public Service Document and Matter Management system. Affidavits of publication will be posted when we receive them.

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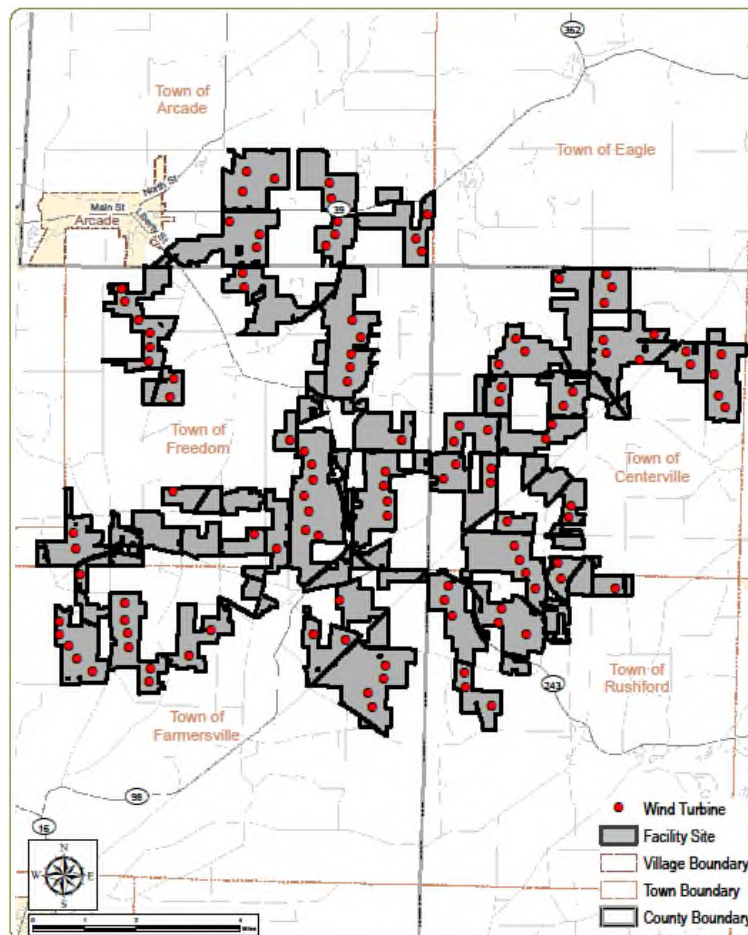

NOTICE OF FILING OF APPLICATION

Alle-Catt Wind Energy LLC (Applicant or Alle-Catt), an affiliate of Invenergy LLC, is proposing to construct a major electric generating facility subject to Article 10 of the New York Public Service Law (Facility). On or about December 11, 2018, the Applicant will file an Application pursuant to Public Service Law (PSL) Section 164 and 16 NYCRR 1000.6 for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need from the New York State Board on Electric Generation Siting and the Environment (Siting Board) authorizing the construction and operation of the Facility. The Application will be filed in Siting Board Case 17-F-0282.

The Facility is a proposed 340 megawatt (MW) wind-powered electric generation facility with up to 117 wind turbines to be located in the Towns of Centerville and Rushford in Allegany County, the Towns of Farmersville and Freedom in Cattaraugus County and the Town of Arcade in Wyoming County, New York, as shown on the map below. The Facility will include commercial-scale wind turbines, access roads, an electrical collection system including lines connecting the wind turbines to a Project Substation, meteorological towers, an operation and maintenance (O&M) building, and electrical interconnection facilities. For Facility construction purposes, Alle-Catt also seeks authority to install and operate a concrete batch plant and construction staging and laydown yards.



Power from the Facility will be delivered to a new point of interconnection (POI) switchyard to be located adjacent to the National Grid's 345 kV line between National Grid's Stolle Road and Five Mile Road substations via an approximately 8-mile long 345 kilovolt (kV) alternating current (AC) overhead transmission facility. The transmission facility, including the POI switchyard, will be the subject of a separate application submitted to the New York Public Service Commission under PSL Article VII.

The Facility will generate electricity from wind, a renewable energy source, reducing air emissions and the use of water resources associated with electricity consumption. The Facility will assist the State in meeting the goals of the State Energy Plan, which include obtaining 50% of electricity consumed in the State from renewable sources by 2030 and significantly reducing greenhouse gas emissions. Other positive impacts include diversification of energy supplies, new employment

opportunities (both temporary construction employment and full-time jobs), increased revenues to county and municipal governments, payments to the local hospitality industry, and purchase of local supplies and goods.

The construction and operation of the Facility may result in minor environmental impacts, including impacts on terrestrial ecology, impacts to avian and bat species; impacts to forested land and wetlands; and visual impacts. Other potential impacts commonly attributed to utility-scale wind energy facilities include noise, shadow flicker, and traffic. The Applicant has designed the Facility layout to meet acceptable standards in these areas and to minimize disturbance to forested lands and wetlands to the maximum extent practicable.

The Applicant intends to submit a request for a Water Quality Certification (WQC) under Section 401 of the federal Clean Water Act, a prerequisite to obtaining a permit from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for the minor disturbance to federally regulated wetlands required to construct the Facility.

Pursuant to the Article 10 process, the Applicant filed a Preliminary Scoping Statement (PSS) with the Siting Board on January 5, 2018. A revised PSS was filed on January 22, 2018, with supplements filed on January 22, 2018 and January 25, 2018. Thereafter, the public had an opportunity to submit comments on the PSS. Following the comment period, the Applicant prepared a summary of the material comments and submitted its reply on March 26, 2018. On March 20, 2018, a pre-application conference to consider pre-application intervenor funding requests was held. On May 18, 2018 Applicant provided notice of consultations to discuss the contents of the Application to a broad list of potential stakeholders. Alle-Catt hosted several telephone conferences between June 21, 2018 and September 4, 2018 to solicit input from stakeholders concerning the content of the Application. Alle-Catt is now ready to file an Application.

The Application includes, among other things: an analysis of the environmental setting of the Facility; a description of the Facility including preliminary design drawings and related information; an assessment of potential land use, environmental and health impacts from construction and operation of the Facility; descriptions of the environmental, economic and other benefits of the Facility; results of studies conducted to prepare the Application, including preconstruction studies to assess potential impacts to avian and bat species; proposed measures to minimize environmental impacts; and a consideration of potential alternatives to the Facility. The Application also addresses consistency with State energy planning objectives, including climate change and renewable energy goals and concerns about public health and safety; terrestrial ecology, water resources and aquatic ecology; communications, transportation and utilities; cultural, historical and recreational resources; visual impacts, including shadow flicker; sound impacts; electric magnetic fields; and impacts on the statewide electrical system. The Article 10 regulations outlining the required contents of the Application can be found at 16 NYCRR 1001.1 et seq.

This notice is being provided in accordance with 16 NYCRR 1000.7 and will be published at least three (3) days prior to the filing of the Application. A copy of the Application will be served on the Chief Executive Officer of each municipality in which any portion of the Facility is located, as well as those persons and agencies enumerated in 16 NYCRR 1000.6.

With the Application, Alle-Catt will deposit \$340,000.00 to be disbursed by the Siting Board to municipalities and other local parties to help pay expenses, including attorney and consultant fees, associated with participating in the Application review process. Fifty percent (50%) of these intervenor funds are reserved for municipalities. Once the Application is filed and determined by the Siting Board to be complete, the Siting Board will schedule a public hearing on the Application. The Siting Board will also issue a notice of availability of intervenor funds to be used by municipalities and local parties to participate in formal review of the Application. Requests for funds must be submitted to the Hearing Examiner within thirty (30) days after the issuance of the notice of the availability of intervenor funds. A pre-hearing conference will be scheduled by the Hearing Examiner to identify intervenors, award intervenor funds, identify issues for the hearing, and establish a case schedule. Additional hearings regarding the Application and project impact assessments will be scheduled by the Hearing Examiner as needed. After hearings, the parties may brief their positions and the Hearing Examiner will issue a recommended decision upon which the Siting Board will base its decision. Article 10 requires that all proceedings on the Application,

including a final decision by the Siting Board, be completed within 12 months of the date the Application is determined to be complete.
