18. Please refer to Exhibit __ (JPB-1) associated with your pre-filed direct testimony. Section 15.4, paragraph b, of Attachment Y of the NYISO OATT states that the NYISO will measure zonal LBMP load savings, considering, among other things, "bilateral contracts (based on available information)."

- a. Please explain the procedure by which NYISO plans to obtain such information, including the sources from which the NYISO believes the information will be available.
- b. Does the NYISO consider information contained in the record of this proceeding to be available information that it would use in the calculation of zonal LBMP load savings? Please explain.

NYISO RESPONSE:

- a. **While the NYISO is in the process of developing the detailed implementation procedures in collaboration with its stakeholders, one of the sources of bilateral contract information would be data provided by the parties to those contracts (under the appropriate confidentiality provisions).**
- b. **As stated in Response "a", above, the NYISO is developing procedures to perform its economic planning process in accordance with the requirements of its federal Tariff. Without knowing the entire contents of the record in this proceeding and its potential relevance to zonal LBMP savings, it does not appear likely that the record in this proceeding, which is being conducted for a different purpose in accordance with the requirements of Article VII of the NYS Public Service Law, would be useful for the calculation of LBMP savings.**
