NOTICE REQUESTING PROPOSALS

(Issued April 20, 2009)

On June 23, 2008, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard and Approving Programs in this proceeding. Within that order, the Commission directed electric utilities, and invited the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority, to submit proposals within 90 days (the "90-day filings") for programs to meet the electric efficiency targets established by the Commission in that Order.

On April 8, 2009, Notices of Proposed Rulemaking were published in the State Register regarding the multifamily and multifamily low-income residential electric efficiency programs (08-E-1127SP1) and large industrial electric energy efficiency programs (08-E-1127SP2) that were filed.

The June 23, 2008 Order did not establish targets for gas efficiency or invite proposals for gas efficiency beyond the "fast track" programs specifically identified in the Order. Several parties did, however, include additional gas efficiency proposals within their 90-day filings. Those gas efficiency proposals have not yet been considered by the Commission.

In anticipation of the Commission considering gas efficiency proposals, persons that have not filed gas efficiency proposals in this proceeding with respect to the categories of multifamily, multifamily low-income, and large industrial as described in the above-referenced Notices of Proposed Rulemaking, may do so on or before April 30, 2009. Parties that filed gas efficiency programs within 90-day filings, but did not

include proposals with respect to the multifamily, multifamily low-income, or large industrial categories, may also file proposals with respect to those categories on or before April 30, 2009.

Parties that filed proposals in 90-day filings with respect to multifamily, multifamily low-income, and large industrial categories, may file updates to such proposals and supporting documentation with respect to those proposals, on or before April 30, 2009.

Persons that have not filed gas efficiency proposals in this proceeding may file proposals with respect to other program categories on or before June 5, 2009. Parties that filed gas efficiency programs within 90-day filings may supplement their proposals with respect to other program categories on or before June 5, 2009.
