In the next four pages from the 814E IG we were thinking that the gray boxes on all four might be better off reading as we propose in the yellow highlighted section.

Especially look at the ICAP and Future ICAP segments in the current version- it says Utility Response: Not Applicable and also Utility Request: Conditional – those don't make sense for the 814E.
