NOTICE SOLICITING COMMENTS AND SCHEDULING MEETING
(Issued April 5, 2016)

In its Order Adopting Regulatory Policy Framework and Implementation Plan, issued February 26, 2015 in Case 14-M-0101, the Commission, <u>inter alia</u>, presented a framework that would establish a distributed system platform (DSP) operator to facilitate the creation of new markets for distributed energy resources (DER), and to coordinate those DER resources when and where implemented.

To address its concerns with potential utility affiliation with DER providers, the Commission noted that codes of conduct by the utilities would be required. Because, however, the Commission found that comments on such codes of conduct were scarce, the Commission directed Department of Public Service Staff (Staff) to initiate a process to address and refine utility codes. This process will be considered in Case 15-M-0501.

Staff has drafted a report (Staff Report) that explores principles for revised utility codes of conduct. The Staff Report may be viewed on the Department's Web site at <a href="www.dps.ny.gov">www.dps.ny.gov</a> by entering the Case number 15-M-0501 from the Search function.
