ORDER SUSPENDING STEAM TARIFF SCHEDULE

(Issued and Effective April 13, 2005)

BY THE COMMISSION:

M-GBC, LLC (M-GBC) filed with this Commission, to become effective May 1, 2005, a new steam tariff schedule (see Appendix) applicable to steam service in Calverton Industrial Park. Department of Public Service Staff, M-GBC and the Calverton Owners Association jointly proposed a procedural schedule regarding the initial steam tariff and the certificates of public convenience and necessity requested in the petition. Accordingly, the new steam tariff schedule will be suspended in order to accommodate the procedural schedule and to afford an opportunity for parties to this proceeding to conduct any necessary discovery.

The Commission orders:

1. Without answer or other formal pleading, a proceeding is instituted concerning the propriety of the rates, charges, rules and regulations contained in the amendments to the tariff schedule listed in the Appendix.

2. Pending the proceeding and decision on the proposed changes, the operation of these amendments are suspended and the use of the rates, charges, rules and regulations is deferred through August 17, 2005, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

3. M-GCB, LLC is directed to file with this Commission, not later than April 18, 2005, a consecutively numbered supplement announcing suspension of the suspended amendments.

4. The proceeding is continued.
