NOTICE MODIFYING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

(Issued February 7, 2012)

Verizon New York Inc. (Verizon) submitted a request dated February 3, 2012, to extend by one month the schedule for filing briefs on exceptions to the January 4, 2012 Recommended Decision in Phase II of this proceeding. The schedule modification is requested to allow time for the parties to attempt to negotiate a settlement of issues related to the Phase II Recommended Decision. The Cable Telecommunications Association of New York, Inc., Level 3 Communications LLC, T-Mobile USA, Inc., tw telecom of new york l.p. support the extension request. The New York State Telephone Association Smaller ILECs and the Utility Intervention Unit of the Department of State's Division of Consumer Protection suggest alternatively that an initial extension of only two weeks would be adequate.
