**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that comments are sought on the Indian Point Closure Task Force 2018 Annual Report and Reuse Study (Report), which was filed on May 9, 2018 in the above referenced matter. The Report identifies anticipated impacts of the closure of Indian Point and provides recommendations on a range of issues including property tax impacts and resources, labor impacts and resources, public safety impacts, decommissioning impacts and reuse analysis. The Report also discusses the additional State Programs that are available as well as the State and Local Legislative and community efforts.
