NOTICE OF TECHNICAL CONFERENCE

(Issued November 30, 2012)

Please take notice that an informal technical conference open to the public has been scheduled for 10:30 a.m. on Monday, December 17, 2012, in the 19th floor Board Room of the Commission's Albany Offices, 3 Empire State Plaza, Albany, New York. In its Order Instituting Proceeding issued November 30, 2012 in Case 12-T-0502 ("the Order"), the Commission requested written public Statements of Intent from developers and transmission owners proposing projects that will increase transfer capacity through certain identified congested transmission corridors. The Commission also directed DPS Staff to work with project sponsors to structure an efficient evaluation process for the review of any specific project applications.

The purpose of the conference is to enable interested parties to obtain a better understanding of the purpose of the Statements of Intent, the information requirements stated in the Order, and the processes that Staff anticipates will apply to the review of specific projects.

The conference will begin with a presentation by DPS Staff explaining the process set to date. Thereafter, conference attendees will be afforded an opportunity to ask questions of the presenters.
