trump to show the minors.

Accordingly, when West, Hemant Lal, led the club 10 against four hearts, declarer had no knowledge of bad breaks ahead. Chorush took dummy's club jack with the king and now had a choice of defenses. A legitimate approach would have been to try to cash a second club or to lead the spade king, looking for a ruff.

Instead, Ira opted for deception by shifting to the spade jack at trick two! Look at it from South's perspective: East, a passed hand who was known to hold the ace and king of clubs, surely did not have the spade king too, since he had never bid. Rather than risk a spade ruff, declarer quite reasonably concluded that it must be better to play for hearts 3-2, in which case there would be just a spade, a heart and a club to lose.

Up went the spade ace, and now declarer simply cashed the heart ace and king to try to avoid any ruffs on defense — and down went the contract!

**ANSWER:** Bid two hearts, a new suit here being natural and forcing. In this sequence you have no idea what suit you will end up in. It best to keep the auction low with natural and forcing calls, letting partner describe his hand further. (Incidentally, many would play a jump to three hearts by you as a splinter — a singleton heart with good diamond support!)

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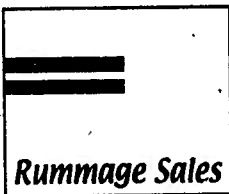

# Paris in the springtime? Brrr, but Venus Williams gets by

**PARIS** | So there was Venus Williams, on center court at the French Open on the final day of May, wearing a sweatshirt, her game as shaky as the weather was dismal.

Thanks to three rain delays totaling nearly 2 hours, Williams was forced to wait until after 8 p.m. to play her second-round match, and only a few hundred bundled-up spectators saw her fall behind 4-0 as the temperature dropped to 50 degrees.

Williams eventually turned things around in the fading light Wednesday night for a 7-6 (2), 6-2 victory over Emma Laine of Finland, a woman who's participated in fewer majors (three) than the American has won (five).

"It's nice to have moments of truth like that early on in the tournament," said Williams, seeded No. 11. "I was able to really kind of focus back in, pull in the reins and really realize what I needed to do."

The match was the perfect up-and-down conclusion to a day of stops and starts, when pretty much everyone complained about the Wimbledon-like weather - even winners such as Roger Federer, Amelie Mauresmo and Maria Sharapova.

Federer's 6-1, 6-4, 6-3 win over Alejandro Falla was held up twice by showers, for about 1 1/2 hours combined; on-court action lasted a mere 86 minutes.

"It's not easy to come on and off" the court, Federer said. "You always hope your game is still there and it hasn't left you."

Fat chance for a player seeking to become the first man since 1969 to win four Grand Slam titles in a row. Federer finished with a 41-13 advantage in winners.

"I would like to win here," said Federer, a champion at every other major at least twice but never past the semifinals in Paris. "The pressure is quite big."

Sharapova didn't show any apparent

signs of the right ankle injury that bothered her in the first round, and moved on 6-4, 6-1 over Iveta Benesova.

"I didn't feel like I was moving great still, being cautious with the tape on," Sharapova said, "but pain wise it felt a lot better."

Williams was playing only her 11th match of the year because of injuries, though she pronounced herself fit afterward. She was rusty at the start, compiling 10 unforced errors by midway through the third game.

But she ran off 11 consecutive points to get back into the match, and her powerful baseline strokes eventually proved too much for Laine.

"She started to play better," Laine said, "and didn't miss so much."

With Williams' father, Richard, sitting in the front row on the sideline, and her shrieks reverberating off thousands of empty green seats, both players thought the match might be halted because of darkness. But Williams took control and finished it.

"Having not played as much as the next person, it's important for me to stay extraordinarily positive and just be really excited about the good things I'm doing," Williams said. "That really builds your morale."

She couldn't recall many Grand Slam matches she's played before so few spectators or in such frigid conditions. Williams had her trainer buy a top with "Roland Garros" written across the front, because she hadn't brought any long-sleeved shirts that would be allowed on court.

"The weather completely changes the tournament. It depends on whether it's sunny, cloudy, raining," 1998 champion Carlos Moya said after beating Mikhail Youzhny 6-3, 6-4, 6-2 to set up a third-round match against No. 6 Nikolay Davydenko. "Now there's something that is totally unprecedented: I haven't seen the sun since I arrived."

# Disappointment as China sees the World Cup from sidelines

**SHANGHAI, CHINA** | Expectations were high four years ago when China made its World Cup debut in what was heralded as the first of many such finals appearances.

This time, though, China failed to even make it through the group stage of qualifying. The closest team will get to experiencing the 2006 World Cup is an exhibition match against France two days before the June 9 opener.

So what went wrong? "The biggest problem is not enough young players," Bora Milutinovic, who coached China at the 2002 World Cup in South Korea and Japan, said in a telephone interview. "They're a long way from competitive soccer."

When China qualified for the 2002 World Cup, it seemed to many observers to be another step in a natural progression toward the top ranks, even after the team bounced out in the group round without scoring a goal in three matches.

Whatever progress China was making, however, came to a screeching halt in November 2004, when its qualifying campaign ended after losing to Kuwait on goal difference.

Yet China's problems involve much more than not scoring goals.

China has struggled to expose its players to the game's most competitive level, failing to overcome a lack of strong soccer tradition and decades of communist isolation and heavy-handed government control.

Few Chinese players have foreign experience, while teams in the Chinese Super League - the top flight domestic league - repeatedly have been distracted by chronic mismanagement and match-fixing scandals.

Among many observers, however, the biggest lament is the national association's failure to implement a strong youth program to develop more homegrown talent. That's especially important because most of the heroes of the 2002 campaign, including former Everton midfielder Li Tie and striker Hao Haidong, are in the twilight of their

careers.

"It's not like in the United States where so many people are playing," said Milutinovic, who has led more teams in the World Cup - five - than any other coach. "There should be a million people playing."

China's soccer woes place the country in an odd position given its prowess in other international sports, placing second in the medal tally at the 2004 Athens Olympics. China is gunning for the top spot when it hosts the 2008 Summer Games in Beijing and is pushing its state-sponsored training program into overdrive.

Coaching changes haven't helped. Milutinovic left his post after the 2002 tournament, and his replacement, Dutch-born Arie Haan, quit following elimination from this year's tournament. Veteran club coach Zhu Guanghu was chosen to pick up the pieces.

China gets its next chance to test its progress in exhibition matches against Switzerland on June 3 and France on June 7.

Soccer remains an enormously popular spectator sport in China. The World Cup is dominating sports pages and driving a market for jerseys and other products associated with the tournament.
