**Errata Filing – Clarification to the Joint Proposal**

Dear Acting Secretary Cohen:

On March 15, 2013, the New York State Public Service Commission approved the Joint Proposal filed by the Signatory Parties in the above referenced proceeding. Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (the “Company”) respectfully submits this letter to correct a typographical error in the Joint Proposal that, if uncorrected, could negatively impact a customer.

In the direct testimony of the Electric Rate Design Panel in Case 12-E-0201, the Company proposed (and the Signatory Parties agreed) to close the SC-2D Veterans Organization Time of Use offering to new subscribers and to migrate customers currently on that service classification to SC-1 or SC-2D, whichever is more beneficial for the customer. Section 3.3(d) of the Joint Proposal, which was drafted to implement that element of the agreement, was inadvertently drafted to provide that existing customers will be migrated to SC-1 or SC-2ND instead of SC-1 or SC-2D.

The Company has performed an analysis of the existing customers to determine whether SC-1 or SC-2D is more beneficial. Because, for one customer, SC-2D is more beneficial than SC-1, the Company wishes to correct the Joint Proposal to remove the extraneous “N” from the service classification designation. Specifically, Section 3.3(d) should read as follows:

The SC-2D- Veterans Organization Optional Time of Use offering will be closed and existing customers will be migrated to SC-1 or SC-2D.

The Company has notified the Signatory Parties of the proposed correction and there are no objections. The Company is in the process of notifying customers of their options to migrate to

certain service classifications and respectfully requests that this change be effective immediately so as to allow customers to elect SC-2D.
