As required by Section K.5. of the Electric Rate Plan adopted by the New York State Public Service Commission in its March 26, 2010 Order in the referenced case, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison” or the “Company”) is filing the report of its Electric Low Income Program for the three-month period ended June 30, 2011, and cumulatively for the entire rate year, which began April 1, 2011.

The report includes program data as of the last day of the quarterly period. The report includes separate data for Westchester County and New York City customers. The data includes the number of customers enrolled; and the number of customers in arrears, the total amount in arrears, and the average amount in arrears. On a rate-year basis, through June 30, 2011, the report includes the aggregate amount of low-income discounts, the number of reconnections for which fees were waived, and the aggregate amount of reconnection fees waived.
