Service Commission Case 99-T-1814. It
involves an original application by
Southern Energy Bowline to construct a 4.2
mile fuel gas transmission line from the
Buena Vista Gas Measuring Station in the
Town of Clarkstown, to a point at or near
Bowline Point in the Town of Haverstraw.

On January 12, 2001 Hudson Valley Gas
Corporation was substituted as the
Applicant.

This Hearing is being held under

Public Service Law 121-A pursuant to a

Commission Order issued January 31, 2001,

and a Notice issued February 2, 2001.

I have been provided with Affidavits of Publication that comply with the request that was made of the Applicant.

Notice of the Hearing was published in the

Rockland County Times, the Rockland
Review, and the Journal News. And those
Affidavits will be filed in the public
file at the Public Service Commission.

The process is quite simple; anyone who wishes to speak can come up and sign a card. Please focus your comments on whether and how the proposed line should be built or identifying any other concerns you would like to address before the Commission makes a decision.

Only persons who sign will be called. And persons who want to comment but don't want to speak can write, and you can get the address from me. Any such letters should be submitted by February 28th.
